# SHELTER

1.6 billion - Almost 22% of the world's population, lives with inadequate shelter in slums or squatting.

That's more than the total populations of North America, South America, and the European Union combined.





# SHELTER

Over 100 million people in the world live with no shelter at all.



# SHELTER



There are currently 65 million refugees in the world which is more than any other time in history.

That is more than the entire population of the United Kingdom

# WATER

783 million people, more than twice the population of the US, are at risk of water related diseases.





# WATER

More than 10% of the world lives without access to clean water. Over 6 million people die each year from unsafe drinking water.

30% of the people without proper sanitation live in Sub-Saharan Africa.

68% of the world breathes air that is in direct violation of WHO standards

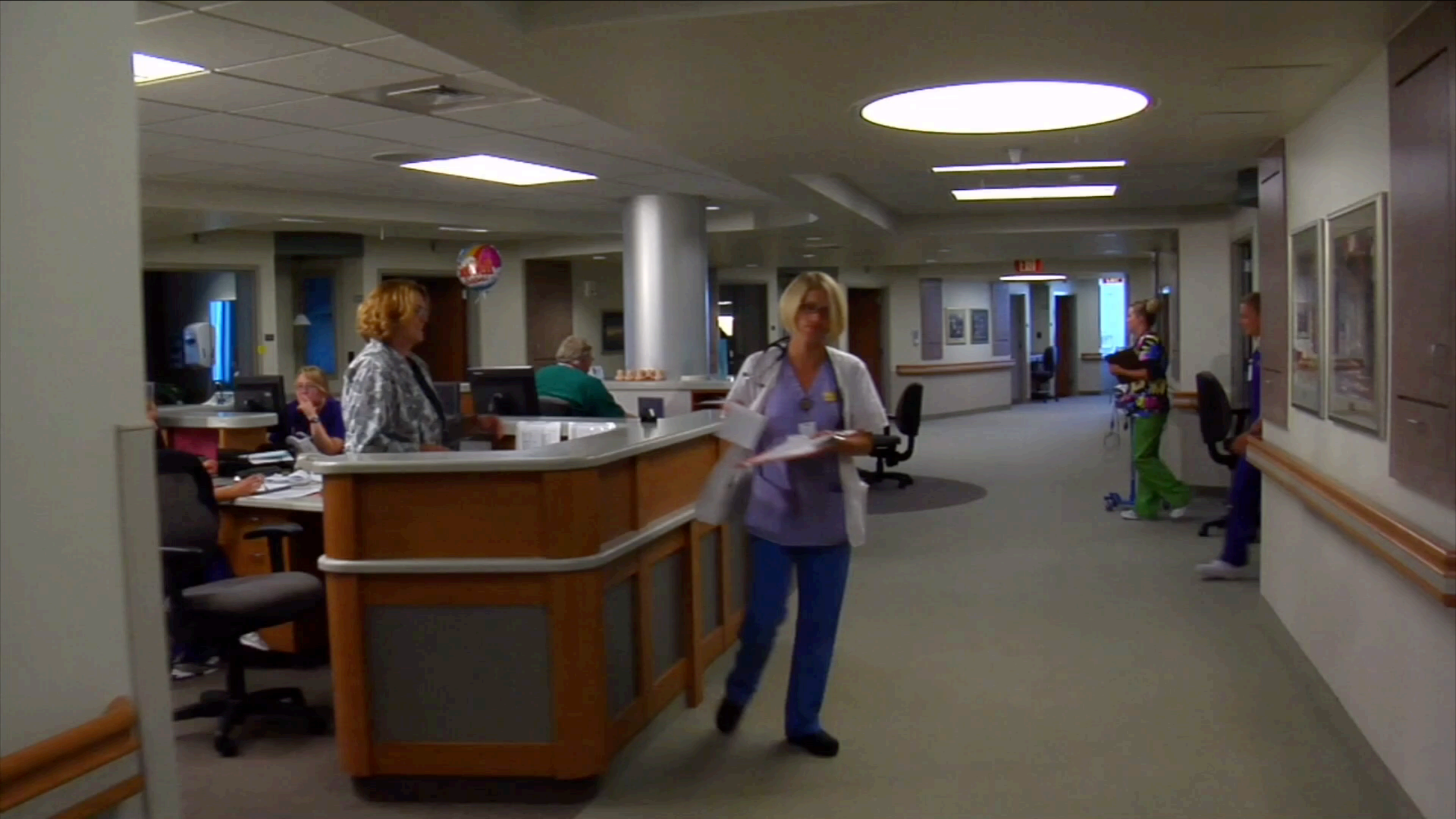


# AIR QUALITY

# HEALTHCARE

400 million people lack access to basic medical services - more than the combined population of the US and Canada



# HEALTHCARE

1 out of 20 pregnancies end in death

1 out of 20 children born will not live to see their  
6th birthday





# HEALTHCARE

- 20% of children around the world are unvaccinated
- 29% of deaths of children under the age of 5 are from vaccine-preventable diseases such as measles, pneumococcal diseases and tetanus.



# HEALTHCARE

- Nearly 37 million people in the world are currently living with HIV - more than the entire population of Canada
- 22 million people currently infected with HIV do not have access to HIV treatment
- More than 24 million infected people live in the Sub-Saharan Africa





# ENERGY

- 1.2 billion people lack electricity
- 621 million people in Africa alone don't have power.





# ENERGY

Running your air conditioner over labor day weekend uses more than the amount of electricity available to someone in Mali (West Africa) for an entire year.

The world's richest 62 people have as much wealth as the world's bottom half which is more than 3.5 billion people

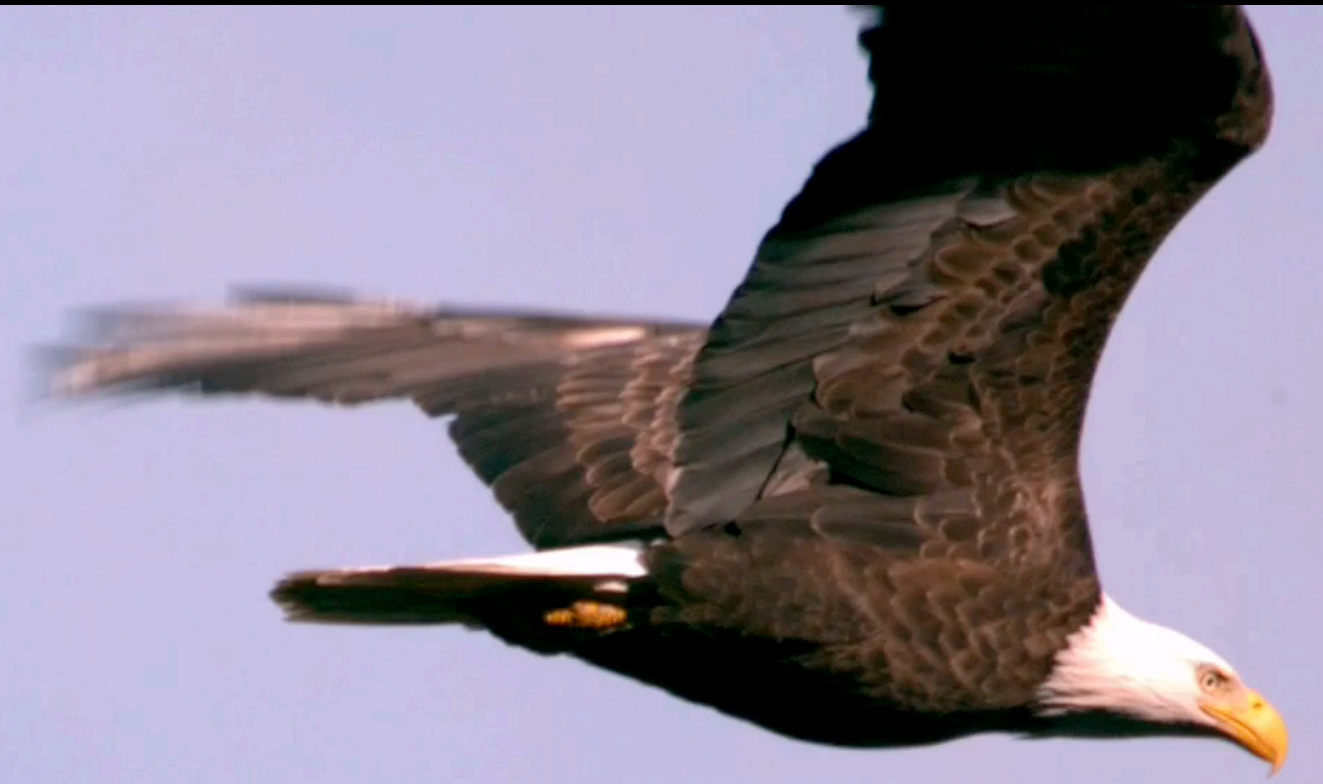




# WEALTH

Around the world, there are 168 million children in child labor, more than half of them in hazardous working conditions.







# FREEDOM

- Almost half of the world lives in fear of harassment, imprisonment, torture, or death
- Can't speak, act according to faith and conscience, due to harassment, imprisonment, torture, or death

# FREEDOM

- There are 36 million people currently in slavery- nearly the number of people in California and more than at any other time in human history
- Over 14 million of the world's slaves are in India
- Mauritania, in Africa, has the world's highest percentage with 4% of their population enslaved



# FREEDOM

- There are an estimated 10 million people around the world currently in prison - that's one person in this room
- The United States has 5% of the world's population but nearly 25% of the prison population

# FREEDOM

- Almost 20% of the world live under constant threat of violence.
- Fear of death by bombardment armed attack, landmines, rape, or kidnapping.



# FREEDOM

- Women aged 15-44 are more at risk from rape and domestic violence than from cancer, car accidents, war and malaria.
